SHAFDAR OUT TO SHINE AT CHELMSFORD

Shafdar really caught the eye last time out and the lightly-raced four-year-old can finally get off the mark in the 'For The Love of Horses' Maiden Stakes at Chelmsford. Already with his third trainer, he made his debut behind a subsequent Group One winner in Twain having started life with Michael Halford and Tracey Collins in Ireland. The Aga Khan homebred was then moved to Mikel Delzangles in France for whom he again had just the one run when fifth of 10 at Amiens. Sent to the sales he was picked up for just E36,000 by the ever so shrewd Ian Williams and he showed plenty of promise at Kempton. The winner, Charlie Appleby's Palladas, cost 750,000 guineas and looks a nice type while the second is a well-bred youngster from Shadwell. Shafdar made fast late gains for third, however, and looks a surefire future winner. Jamie and Saffie Osborne have been racking up the air miles of late, back and forth to Dubai, but little fish are sweet and Aneirin's Sword can prevail in the 7th March Artful Dodger After Racing Handicap. The Mehmas gelding showed little in three runs in maiden and novice company but got off the mark at the first attempt in handicap company off a mark of 60 when dead-heating. He was beaten just three-quarters of a length when attempting to follow up but the race was not run to suit and he made plenty of ground up late. Nudged up another 2lb, he should still be hard to beat. Harlington has been in good form recently and can defy a 6lb rise in the 5th July Queen Charlotte Day Handicap. He left Joe Tickle and joined Charlie Clover and was second on his first start for new connections at Southwell. At Lingfield last time out he was a convincing winner and the 6lb rise was to be expected. Testing ground seems to bring out the best in Esprit Du Potier and he will definitely have that in the Border Minstrel Sunday Lunch Handicap Hurdle at Newcastle. It is fair to say he has not quite lived up to his early promise as, having won in heavy ground at Gosforth Park in March 2024, Lucinda Russell took him to Aintree for a Grade One won by Brighterdaysahead. She has just won the Irish Champion Hurdle and Esprit Du Potier was not totally disgraced in seventh but he missed the whole of last season and has struggled to date this term. He looks ready for three miles in heavy ground, though, and it may be a case of who handles it best. Gentleman Bill only ran three days ago at Doncaster but fell at halfway and can make swift amends in the Cinch Self Storage cinchstorage.co.uk Novices' Handicap Chase. He is a horse who always seems well fancied, and on bits of his form he probably should be better than a 122-rated chaser. This represents a drop in grade from his usual races, though, and defeat here will leave him running out of options. Jimmy Moffatt's Union Avenue is given one more chance in the Virgin Bet A Good Bet Maiden Hurdle. A winner of two bumpers, he was then ninth of 19 in the championship event at Cheltenham when an unconsidered 125-1 shot. He was sent off even money favourite for his return after more than 600 days off so was obviously expected to have retained all his ability and be fit. However, as soon as he was headed he weakened very quickly and was pulled up. He wears cheekpieces for the first time here and that may spark him back to life.
